## COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM INFORMATION

---

The George Bush Foundation Community Grant Program is designed to support and enhance the Brazos Valley community by giving restricted grants in amounts up to \$10,000 per qualifying organization.

### Eligible Recipients

- Non-profit organizations located in the Brazos Valley which are open to public participation and tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code
- Texas A&M University registered and recognized student organizations

### Ineligible Recipients

- Individuals
- Political causes, candidates or campaigns
- Private charities or foundations
- Endowments or capital campaigns
- Churches
- Video or film production
- Start-up funding for organizations

### General Requirements

- You should be a non-partisan organization with the primary goal of improving local education, supporting the community or enriching local art/culture.
- You must complete the application provided. Please do not submit brochures, DVDs or other materials.
- Applications must be submitted on-line at [www.bush41.org](http://www.bush41.org) no later than October 31st of each year. A copy of your 501(c)(3) determination letter or proof of Texas A&M recognized student organization status must be submitted to [grants@bush41.org](mailto:grants@bush41.org).
- Award letters will be distributed in December. Funding will be awarded in January.
- Any money awarded must be used in the calendar year received. Remaining amounts must be returned to the George Bush Foundation no later than January 31st of the subsequent year.
- A grant evaluation report is required upon completion of the award period. Reports are due by December 1st of the award year. Failure to supply the report by December 1st will result in revocation of grant funds and preclude submission of future applications.
